Journal of the English Literary Society of Doshisha University

- Doshisha Literature, a journal of the English Literary Society of Doshisha University, is primarily concerned with English and American literature, English linguistics, applied linguistics (teaching English as a second language), and the comparison of English with other languages (especially Japanese).
- 2. *Doshisha Literature* is published once a year and all the articles are in English. Articles are restricted to unpublished work, but papers delivered at an academic conference are eligible when that fact is noted.
- 3. Submissions will be accepted only from current Members of the Society or those whose contribution is approved by the editorial board.
- 4. Articles are usually expected to be no longer than approximately 7000 words, not including references and endnotes (25 lines per page at 70 letters per line with margins of at least 2.5cm on all sides). Authors are requested to follow the latest MLA or APA style sheets.
- 5. Manuscripts should not include the name of the author but instead be accompanied by a separate page with the title, the author's name, his or her affiliation, mailing address, telephone number, and email address if available. Acknowledgements and note(s) clearly identifying the author should be included on a separate page.
- 6. Authors are requested to send the manuscript in both MS Word and PDF formats to the following e-mail address:

Authors whose manuscripts have been accepted are also requested to submit their final manuscripts together with short biographical notes to the same e-mail address.

- 7. The manuscript will be evaluated by two qualified referees, and finally the editorial board will decide whether to accept or reject it.
- 8. Authors are responsible for the first and the second proofreading. Corrections should be limited to typographical errors.
- 9. It is advisable that, prior to submission, manuscripts be corrected and edited by a qualified native speaker of English.
- 10. Submitted articles may be reproduced electronically on Doshisha University Academic Repository, or other such media, at the discretion of the editorial board of *Doshisha Literature*.
- 11. The copyrights of the contributions published in *Doshisha Literature* belong to the English Literary Society of Doshisha University. No unauthorized reproduction or modification is permitted. If authors want to reproduce their contributions, they must consult the editorial board and obtain permission.

DOSHISHA LITERATURE

Doshisha Literature is published by the English Literary Society of Doshisha University, Kyoto, Japan. The predecessor of the present periodical, Doshisha Bungaku, first appeared in 1887 but was abolished in 1895. In 1903 an unsuccessful attempt was made to revive it, but it was not until 1927 that the journal was re-issued. After nine years, Doshisha Bungaku developed into two different publications: Shuryu (The Main Current), a journal devoted to criticism and creative writing; and Doshisha Bungaku Pamphlet, for scholarly monographs. At the end of World War II, Shuryu was revived but the other was not.

In 1956 Doshisha Bungaku re-appeared as Doshisha Literature, an English language periodical for scholarly articles and creative writing and translations. This is the forty-seventh issue of Doshisha Literature, but serial numbers are continued from the initial publication of Doshisha Bungaku in 1927.
